Reccomended Items:

- Dish soap
- Sponge/dish scrubber
- Paper towels
- All purpose cleaners
- Hand soap
- Paper towels
- Toilet paper



What can be used as a “basket”?

You can gather these supplies in bags, bins, baskets—anywhere you can fit all the items will work!

- Small laundry basket
- Small trashcan
- Drawstring backpack
- Reusable grocery bags
- Storage bins

CREATE A HYGIENE KIT

Our Unarmed Crisis Response teams and ICMS case managers often interact with individuals experiencing street-level homelessness. Each of these individuals have different needs for services and resources, but one of the requests we get the most frequently is simply hygiene supplies.

Help us meet that demand by creating a Hygiene Kit and gift someone in your community the tools to take care of themselves. Feel free to supplement with additional items like chapstick, lotion, hand sanitizer, etc. — any self-care tools you think would benefit someone in need.

Recommended Items:

- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Small shampoo + conditioner bottles
- Body wash/bar soap
- Deodorant
- Wet wipes
- Socks
- Hand sanitizer

These supplies can be assembled together in any sort of bag that will fit everything. This can be a toiletry bag, a small tote bag, a drawstring backpack, or even something as simple as a gallon sized resealable plastic bag.



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
